The FCC program offers quality care for children ranging from two weeks to 12 years of age by licensed, professional childcare providers. It is an excellent choice for families who prefer a family-style and small group setting.

### Becoming a FCC Provider

Are you interested in helping MHAFB's growing need for childcare? In a mere four weeks, we can get you licensed and ready to go! To operate a FCC home, applicants will be screened by local base agencies. Applicants are required to obtain liability insurance and must pass home inspections which include Health, Fire, Program, and Safety components. Applicants must also complete a one-week orientation training course.



## FCC PROVIDER BENEFITS

Personally and professionally, the provider is able to be his/her own boss while working to assist his/her spouse in growing the family's income.

With regard to society, the Family Child Care Provider supports developmental growth in a homelike "family" atmosphere.
