

To provide a safe, enriching, supervised environment for children, we support their development as follows: Personal Development, Social Development, Physical Development, and Cognitive Development. Offered monthly, these events focus on age appropriate activities strengthening development. Average attendance is 127 children and 100 parents.

Give Parents a Break

GPAB is a program supported by the Air Force Aid Society to provide quality childcare to deployed families and families in hardship. This program is designed to give families much needed stress relief and enhance wing resiliency. Care is offered for 8 hours one Saturday a month. Average attendance is 21.


Parents Day Out

FITNESS CENTER

We offer a variety of programs and equipment for physical health and recreational activities. Our Cardio Theater is lined with 58 cardio machines. Our Resistance Training Room has three complete circuits for a total body workout. The Weight Training Room houses our free weights. We offer a large exercise room for group aerobic workouts and specialized training sessions. Our small group exercise room has 34 spinning bikes and two large screen televisions used to play course videos while classes are in session. The Parent/Child Supervised Workout Area is available for parents who still wish to stay in shape. Each locker room has a family changing area, private showers and a sauna.

The fitness center offers two racquetball courts and two basketball courts. Outdoor recreational facilities include basketball courts located near the dormitories, two softball fields, an outdoor running track, indoor running track, a football and soccer field, a multipurpose field, and two tennis courts. A variety of classes are offered monthly, including step aerobics, spinning, and circuit training.


LIBRARY

Idaho provides a dramatic backdrop for trips ranging from white water rafting and kayaking to cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. We offer rock climbing, hiking, gold panning, backpacking (beginner and advanced), and camping.

Hell's Canyon

Multi-day rafting trip through beautiful Hell's Canyon. This 4 day 3 night adventure tackles whitewater up to class IV, with Dutch oven cooking, hiking, fishing and camping. We have two trips per year and average 12-16 customers per trip.

SILVER SAGE GOLF COURSE

Designed by Bob E. Baldock in 1953 and recently renovated in 2012 by Golf Creations of Marengo, Illinois, Silver Sage Golf Course is set in Idaho's high desert, successfully uniting golf with native habitat. A challenging 6959 yard par 72 military golf course, Silver Sage boasts brand new USGA greens seeded with Dominant Extreme creeping bent grass which provides an undulating, firm, fast putting surface. New USGA bunkers add challenge to nearly every approach shot. The course offers 4 sets of tees to accommodate all skill levels. With a rating of 72 and a slope of 128, our back tees will pose a challenge to even the most accomplished player.



Base Golf Championship

Our three day championship tournament consists of over 54 holes of medal play competition. To raise the stakes and the fun we offer net and gross champions a Season Pass for the next year and a personalized champion's locker. Average attendance is 75.

Night Golf

These events consist of four person teams making their way through a scramble format game of golf at night! How can they see you might ask? The course, flags, and golf ball will be illuminated to help participants navigate the course.

YOUTH CENTER

From dances to water fights, sports tournaments to crafts, kids are sure to find something they enjoy at the Youth Center. Youth Programs offers programming for children ages 6 through 18. The center is affiliated with the Boys and Girls Clubs of American and 4-H. Exciting and challenging programs are offered, giving youth opportunities to learn, win prizes, awards and national recognition. We host several clubs for a variety of age ranges and interests.

Youth Programs have year-round sports programs for children ages 4 to 18. Registration fees vary by sport. Our Nationally Accredited School-Age Program provides supervised, developmentally appropriate programming for children 6 to 12 years of age during the hours before and after school, on school holidays, and during the summer and winter school breaks. We also offer family programs such as skate nights, fishing, and carnivals.
