Transferability of Education Benefits Acknowledgments

- a) I am eligible for the Post-9/11 GI Bill, the program I am applying to transfer. I acknowledge that transferability is not an entitlement, and I should not presume automatic approval of my request. Accordingly, I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to check the status of my request's progress via this website. If my request is approved and as evidence an approval letter is auto-generated, I will pick up the letter via this website. Because I am the Service Member, the approval letter is addressed to me and lists the approved terms of transfer, including my specific Service Obligation End Date and the allocation of benefits per dependent. I acknowledge that without an auto-generated approval letter, I have not been approved to transfer my benefits.
- b) I understand I may transfer up to 36 months (or my remaining months of eligibility, whichever is less) of my education benefits to my eligible dependents. I may access a formal statement of the number of months of education benefits to which I am entitled at the following website: www.va.gov/education/gi-bill/post-9-11/ch-33-benefit. I retain the right to modify or revoke months of education benefits, designated to eligible and approved dependents, at any time until they are exhausted after approval without incurring an additional obligation. At the same time, I understand that I may not change a 0-month designation of benefits once I am separated, retired, or discharged. Accordingly, I acknowledge that I have been advised to designate at least 1 month of benefits to each eligible dependent prior to my separation from the Armed Forces (i.e. Active Duty or Selected Reserve).
- c) I understand that my spouse may use the benefit immediately and children (ages 18-26) after I have served 10 years. Note: This condition does not apply to Purple Heart recipients.
- d) I understand and agree to remain in the Armed Forces, with no break in Active Duty or Selected Reserve service for greater than 24 hours, for four years from the date of this transfer request. Eligibility does not guarantee approval. This service obligation does not apply to Purple Heart recipients who are still serving in the Armed Forces when they apply to transfer education benefits. I understand that failure to complete my service obligation may lead to my dependent(s) losing their entitlement. If the Department of Veterans Affairs has already made payments before the entitlements were lost, these payments become overpayments.
- e) I understand that I am responsible for reimbursing the Department of Veterans Affairs for any overpayments due to not completing my additional obligated term of service agreement. (Service documentation will remain on file with the Service.)
- f) **I understand that in order to request this transfer, if I'm eligible for the MGIB (Chapter 30, 38 USC), or the MGIB-SR (Chapter 1606, 10 USC), I am converting from that program to the Post-9/11 GI Bill. This conversion is irrevocable.**
- g) I understand I cannot receive more than a total of 48 months of benefits under two or more programs.
- h) If electing Chapter 33 in lieu of Chapter 30, my months of entitlement under Chapter 33 will be limited to the number of months of entitlement remaining under Chapter 30 on the effective date of my election. However, if I completely exhaust my entitlement remaining under Chapter 30 before the effective date of my Chapter 33 election, I may receive up to 12 additional months of benefits under Chapter 33.
- i) My conversion to the Post-9/11 GI Bill is **irrevocable** and may not be changed.
- j) As a Service Member or Veteran with only one qualifying period of service for GI Bill purposes after 31 July 2011, and who has elected and used some GI Bill entitlement (other than the Post 9/11 GI Bill), I will not be eligible for Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits. Therefore, I will not be eligible to transfer Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits to dependents.

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Message from Your Service Component

Message from Your Service Component: All personnel must meet qualifying criteria and procedures outlined in DoDI 1341.13, Change 1, Post-9/11 GI Bill, Enclosure 3, AFI 36-2670, Total Force Development (6.11.15.1.1., 6.11.15.8.) and the Post-9/11 GI Bill Personnel Services Delivery Guide (PSDG) located on myPers (https://mypers.af.mil/app/answers/detail/a_id/9020) to apply and gain approval for the Transfer of Education Benefits (TEB). TEB applications WILL NOT be approved unless the member has or obtains retainability for 4 years from the date of application AND signs/submits the required TEB Statement of Understanding (SOU). Please validate all myPers email addresses, as you will receive initial notification of application receipt and further instruction via myPers Total Force Service Center (TFSC) email. If you DO NOT receive an email within 7 calendar days, contact the TFSC at 1-800-525-0102 ASAP. All TEB requirements must be met within 30 calendar days of the initial TFSC notification or the application will be rejected (disapproved). Once an application is rejected, members MUST reapply and secure retainability from the NEW date of application. DO NOT apply and obtain approval for TEB unless you are willing to complete the associated Active Duty Service Commitment (ADSC). Revoking transferred benefits will NOT revoke the ADSC, even if benefits have not been used. An ADSC waiver allowing members to separate or retire from active duty is NOT equivalent to having transferred benefits permanently "vested" with dependents. Members FORFEIT transferred benefits if the associated service obligation is not complete and the application will be rejected (disapproved). Any benefits used are subject to recoupment by the Department of Veterans Affairs. If required, the Military Personnel Flight should extent member the minimum number of months to meet the transfer requirements plus 30 days or process the reenlistment IAW the Post-9/11 PSDG, section C and AFI 36-2606, Reenlistment and Extension of Enlistment in the United States Air Force.
